PREFACE

Although this Standard was prepared by the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee on Children's Toys, it was agreed that this edition be published as an Australian Standard solely. Subsequent editions however, are to be published as Joint Australian/New Zealand Standards. This Standard relates to the toxicological requirements of children's toys and supersedes AS 1647.3—1982.
