EOLAS - The Irish Science and Technology Agency in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (3) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Science and Technology Act, 1987 (No. 30 of 1987), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Protective Clothing – Protection Against Liquid Chemicals – Test Method: Resistance of Materials to Penetration by Liquids) Declaration, 1993.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Protective Clothing – Protection Against Liquid Chemicals – Test Method: Resistance of Materials to Penetration by Liquids. The Schedule comprises the text of EN 368 : 1992.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN 368 : 1993 or as I.S./EN 368 : 1993.
